A note on paint... I recommend using what you have, or what you can afford. I prefer Golden Fluid Acrylics, the pigments are very strong and give me the best darks I can mix. I will use heavy body acrylic if I run out, or need to, I can change the consistency of the paint with water. All the colours I use daily are transparent, this makes your artwork glow and is only useful if you glaze or layer your paint. My pallet includes at least one warm and a cool (sometimes multiples) of each primary color, plus white and umber.
